

### Emergency Delivery in the ED

**\*\*This is only for babies that are born IN the ED\*\***

**\*\*\*Triage baby IF BORN OUTSIDE THE HOSPITAL with CEDIS Complaint: Newly Born\*\*\***

#### ED

- Triage mom as an emergency encounter.
- Document birth on **OBS Summary sheet on paper**.
- **Consult OB** and have them place the **PAO for admission on mom**.
- Once baby is born **DO NOT TRIAGE**. Call W&B to have the Newborn registration complete.
- Information needed: Date, time, sex
- Confirm PAO for admission on Birth parent is completed.
- **The on-Call pediatrician will be the MRP for the baby and place PAO.**
- Get the FIN of the baby.

#### W&B


- OB registration clerk to navigate to the **Conversation Launcher**, initiate **Newborn Quick Admit** conversation and then **Search** birth parent, this will link birth parent and baby.
- In collaboration with the ED fill out mandatory fields associated to the NB Quick Admit.
- **IMPORTANT NOTE:** ED staff to tell the W&B's staff a room in the ED that is empty. Try to find an ED Bed close to mom \*\*\*\*\*not then same bed\*\*\*\*\*
- **E.G.** Under INPATIENT/AMBULATORY UNIT select WSED/NHSED/SCSED then select BED AVAILABILITY and click the BED that the ED will tell you to.

**ED staff** can now see the newborn on LaunchPoint

- Move baby on LaunchPoint to moms room.
- Right click on the patient and Set Event. Change the Status for Triage and Registration to cancel for the baby. Apply.

- Go to the **Documents** tab to adHoc print the patients arm band. Select Wristband w/Visit ID and then select the printer icon on the top left.
- Baby documentation after birth to be done in the **Pediatric Systems Assessment**.
- Arrange for transportation.
- Transfer to be completed in Capacity Management by ED.
