 - Click the green checkmark 🖌 to sign documentation when completed
 - **NOTE**: This is important as some fields documented here will route to the discharge instructions that will be printed for families





 - Navigate to the Documentation section and select the Prescriber's Newborn Discharge 0 Note. Discharge note will populate on the right side of the screen.





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13) To discharge the newborn out of the system once they have left the unit:

- Discharging birth parent and newborn at the same time:
 - Since mom and newborn are linked, a Newborn Discharge Dialog box opens after parent is discharged. Right-click anywhere on newborn's row and select the applicable action:
 - Copy Discharge: If newborn is discharged at the same time as mom, this will copy the discharge information and discharge newborn from the system
 - Modify Discharge: If there are any modifications to be done to the discharge • details for the newborn. Once completed, this will discharge newborn from the svstem

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Note: You may need to refresh the SCS Newborn tracking board to see the patient drop off the tracking board


