


Recap – Practice Readiness Week 2

• Follow Up Orders & Tasking

- After assessing a patient and determining that ongoing treatment is required, the therapists are going to place a Follow Up order to task themselves their documentation
- Tasking for therapists is based on how frequently they wish to document, not how often the patient needs treatment
- Therapists are tasked with their treatment documentation, RAs and CDAs are not

Follow Up Order in Orders section of Patient's Chart

• Follow Up Orders & Tasking cont'd...

- Follow Up Orders owned by that discipline, can be canceled/discontinued, and modified at any time
- Used to enhanced continuity of care, improve communication and visibility to the care team, and to help with documentation standards/compliance

Flowsheet Documentation

- PT, OT, RA, Rec Therapy and Rec Therapy Assistants utilize the Last Charted Value (LCV) – where the latest data entered in the ultra-grids flows into newly opened PowerForms
 - In order to add to the flowsheet, therapists and assistants need to write over previously entered data to update the flowsheet ***Nothing is erased, you're adding to the flowsheet***
- PT, OT, and RA utilize the PT Instructions and OT Instructions rich text boxes, which flow into the RA's PowerForm as a read-only smart template
 - Therapists use the instructions area to specify which flowsheet they want the RA to work on, any safety parameters/notes, or special considerations





• Flowsheet Documentation - cont'd...

- SLP/CDA Treatment Flowsheet list up to 15 activities
- Goals, Activities, Score, Cueing, and Comment areas
- Does not utilize Last Charted Value (LCV) functionality
- CDAs have same grid format in their treatment PowerForms
- The SLPs and CDAs should look to the SLP Short-Term Goals (STGs) section of their PowerForms to access STGs for treatment guidance. This uses Last Charted Value (LCV) functionality





- Results Review vs Textual Rendition Reviewing Flowsheet Documentation
 - Textual Rendition is found through the Documentation tab, and Results Review through Results Review tab on blue Table of Contents Menu
 - Can track trends over time, compare results with previous data

Writing STGs, LTGs, and SMART Goals

- In current state:
 - Document Short Term Goals (STGs) and Long Term Goals (LTGs) on paper (in assessment and progress notes), rewriting to update as needed
 - SMART Goals document in patient's paper chart
 - Requested by Case Managers to write SMART Goals for their rehab referral
 - Write SMART Goals to help home care prioritize community services
 - Recommend ongoing inpatient rehab from acute care to the care team document this in our assessment and/or progress notes

- Proposing Orders
 - Standardized process for proposing orders
 - Built in Communication Types to allow the proposed order to initiate
 - All proposed orders will be sent to the attending Prescriber for review and co-sign
 - Notified via their Message Center
 - Once signed by the Prescriber, the order status changes to "Ordered" on the patient's chart
 - Examples of proposed orders:
 - Interprofessional Consults
 - Bed Specialty Surface
 - NPO
 - VFSA





Future State – Practice Change – Orders...cont'd

- Placing Orders
 - Can place orders if access and privilege has been given
 - No co-sign needed
 - All placed orders will be published in the Orders section of the patient's chart immediately upon ordering
 - When we have access and privilege to an order, we can cancel/discontinue or void that order from the Orders section of the patient's chart
 - Examples of accessible orders to therapists:
 - Diet Orders (SLP), CDA Screening (SLP)
 - Interprofessional Consults (Home Care, Spiritual Care, etc.)
 - Therapy Follow Up Orders


