

Hamilton Pediatric Early Warning System (HPEWS) will be generated once the following assessments are documented:

- 1. Pulse/Heart Rate
- 2. Respiratory Rate
- 3. Respiratory Effort
- 4. Oxygen Saturation
- 5. Systolic Blood Pressure
- 6. Alert, Voice, Pain, Unresponsive
- 7. Oxygen Therapy and/or FiO2
- 8. Central Refill

To Document the required assessments and obtain an HPEWS score, navigate to the **Pediatric Quick View** band in the **Interactive View and I&O** section. Once documentation has been completed, click on

the green checkmark to sign it. Click on the Refresh icon $\frac{6}{2}$ to the top right to retrieve the HPEWS score indicated in the yellow box seen below.

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HPEWS Scores will be indicated using a colour system Green (0-2), Yellow (3-5), Orange (6-9), and Red (>9). A green (0-2) score will not generate a discern alert as there is no action required. In the Discern Alert images below, note the HPEWS Score and the Nursing Interventions (in red text) that must be completed. To close the Discern Alert, click on the Red X as noted in the bottom right screenshot.

 If patient remains in Yellow, notify Charge Nurse, RT if applicable, and MD on-call (MD to attend in <4 hours).
- Continue q90minutes HPEWS unless otherwise specified by MD.
 Consider continuous monitoring (cardiac monitor or continuous oxygen saturations as ordered)

HPEWS Score (10)

- HPEWS Score >9 Initiate Nursing Intervention: 1. Notify Charge Nurse
- Call MD on-call (MD to attend in <15 minutes).
- . Notify RT
- 4. Continuous monitoring (cardiac monitor or continuous oxygen saturations as ordered).
- 1:1 nurse to patient ratio.
- Vital signs q15 minutes unless otherwise specified by the MD.
 HPEWS repeated with 30 minutes.
- 8. If patient remains in Red, the MD, RT, and Charge Nurse must be notified again.

- 4. Continuous monitoring (cardiac monitor or continuous oxygen saturations as ordered)
- Charge Nurse to review nurse to patient ratio
 Vital signs 15-60 minutes unless otherwise specified by the MD.
- 7. HPEWS repeated with 60 minutes
- 8. If patient remains in Orange, the MD, RT, and Charge Nurse must be notified again.
