

CRITICAL EVENT (CODE BLUE/PINK)

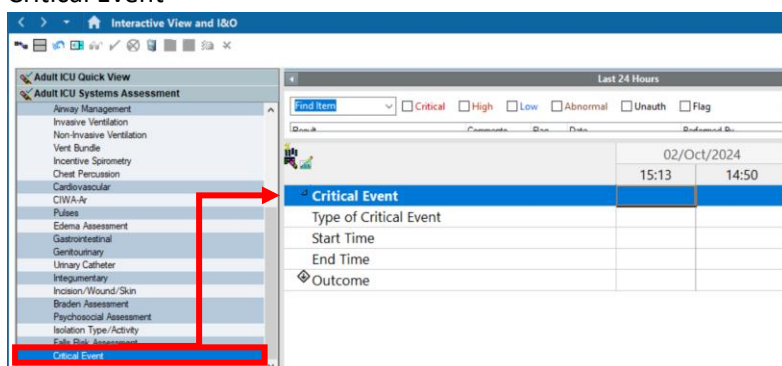
- The documentation **during** a Critical Event (Code Blue/Pink) remains the same as before, using the **Adult/Pediatric Resuscitation Record** paper form. This document is located and can be printed from the Emergency Resource Directory (Emergency Codes Icon) on the SourceNet home page (<https://erd.res.lhiniv.net/web/list/326>) This form will also still be available on all the clipboards on the Code Blue Carts.



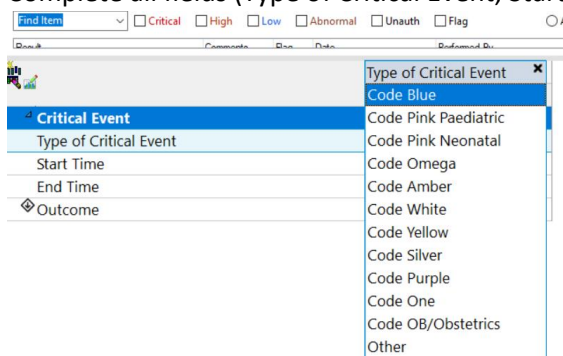

Once the Critical Event (Code Blue/Pink) has ended, the following steps must also be completed:

- Open the Interactive View and I&O section of PowerChart, under Adult Systems Assessment, click on Critical Event



- Complete all fields (Type of Critical Event, Start Time, End Time, and Outcome)



- The **Adult/Pediatric Resuscitation Record** needs to remain in the physical, paper chart and will be scanned into the electronic chart after discharge by HIM.
