

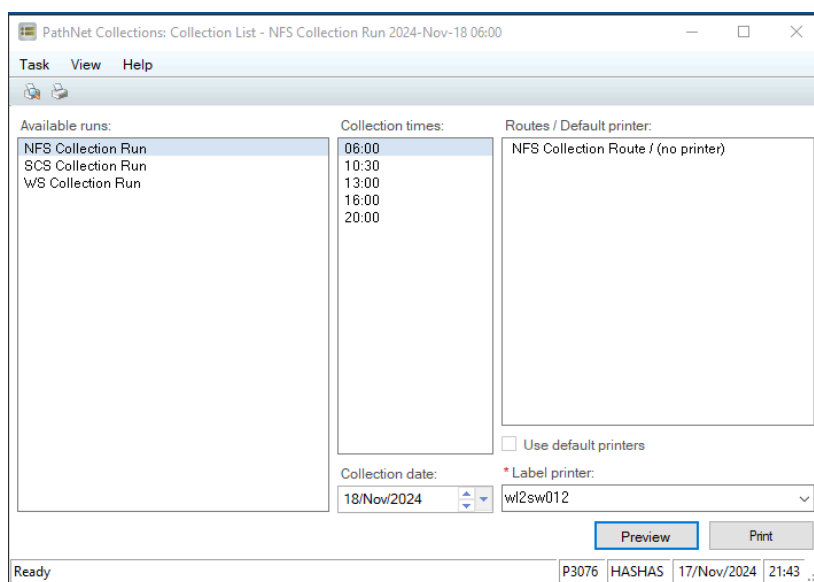
Nurse collect Vs Lab Collect

Different ways orders can be placed for collection:

1. Any lab tests ordered as **Urgent/STAT** and **Nurse Collect = No** will fall into powerchart specimen collection and collection runs within powerchart.
2. Any lab tests ordered as **Routine/Urgent/STAT** and **Nurse Collect = Yes** will also appear in powerchart specimen collection.
3. Any lab tests ordered as **Routine** and **Nurse Collect = No** will fall on the next collection runs. It will not be visible in collections runs tab at the time or powerchart specimen collection until its time for the lab run itself. Lab can confirm this by going into the *Collection List* application and selecting preview for the next collection run.

Make sure to select a printer and hit **Preview** to view the specimens to collect.

IMPORTANT NOTE: clicking on Print will print all the labels for that collection run

You can highlight a patient name and select details to see what orders are to be collected for that patient.

The list compiles 5 minutes prior to each run, therefore if you see multiple orders (Ex. 5 CBCs for 6 am) you need not worry, as we have rules in place which will cancel all orders except for one.
