


PATIENT ADMISSION ORDER HOSPITAL INFORMATION SYSTEM (HIS)

For newborns born at Niagara Health and are staying with mom on Postpartum OR homebirths in less than 24 hours:

- Medical Service: Newborn

Level of Care: Nursery

- Request Bed Assignment: Direct Admit



For newborns born at Niagara Health going to the NICU:

- Medical Service: Newborn

- Level of Care: Neonatal Intensive Care Unit




HOSPITAL INFORMATION SYSTEM (HIS)



For newborns born in an external hospital being admitted to the NICU (E.g from McMaster):

Medical Service: Neonatology

Level of Care: Neonatal Intensive Care Unit










PATIENT ADMISSION ORDER HOSPITAL INFORMATION SYSTEM (HIS)

For bilirubin clinic readmits:

Medical Service: Pediatrics

- Level of Care: Post partum or Pediatrics ward

- Request Bed Assignment: Direct Admit



Patient Admission Orders for Labouring Patients and Postpartum Patients

For labouring patients:

Medical Service: Obstetrics

- Level of Care: Obstetrics Ward




HOSPITAL INFORMATION SYSTEM (HIS)



For Postpartum care only patients:

Medical Service: Obstetrics

- Level of Care: Post partum









PATIENT ADMISSION ORDER HOSPITAL INFORMATION SYSTEM (HIS)

*If a pediatric patient is coming from ED or an outbound hospital (E.g McMaster):

- Medical Service: Pediatrics

- Level of Care: Pediatric ward

- Request Bed Assignment: will need to depend on where they are coming from

 E.g patient admitted from ED, will need to request new bed assignment through Capacity Management

o E.g McMaster admit would be a direct admission
