BRIDGE Breast Milk Management

October 2024

Current Practice: Breast milk management in current state involves receiving expressed breast milk (EBM) from mother, storing the milk, and administrating milk to baby.

Practice/Process Change: BRIDGE Breast Milk Management is a program that enhances safety around the storage and administration of breast milk.

BRIDGE electronically captures the entire flow of EBM using specific bottle labels. This scanning-based program serves as the second check in safely receiving, combining, fortifying, and administering EBM to baby.

BRIDGE is launched from PowerChart using a <u>link</u> in the top toolbar, and opens into a separate window.

Important Messages

- BRIDGE is 100% scanning-based for safety
- Bottle labels are freezer and fridge stable
- Bottle label printers stationed by freezer and at each fridge
- Stationary computer in both NICU milk prep areas
- Workflow options are available for all steps in the EBM process
