



Fix for accidental change to "Service interaction"

Bed Monitors

- 1. The recurring revisit was registered incorrectly and has changed the <u>Parent</u> encounter type from **Recurring** to **Service Interaction**.
- 1. Open up Access Management Office/Conversation Launcher. The first step to correct the encounter type on the parent encounter is to cancel the discharge. Choose the Cancel Discharge conversation. **For any encounters discharged more than 24 hours ago, please call the Bed Monitor as they are the only position that has access to cancel the discharge after 24 hours.**




2. Search for the patient using the **FIN** or health card number if available, or Health Card/First and Last name/DOB if FIN is not available.






3. In the top pane, highlight the correct patient, in the bottom pane highlight the encounter that needs to have the discharge undone and click **OK**.






4. The conversation will launch. Choose the **Cancel Discharge Reason.** Click "ok" to file the conversation.




5. In Access Management Office/Conversation Launcher. Choose the OP Ambulatory Registration conversation.



6. Search for the patient using the **FIN** or health card number if available, or Health Card/First and Last name/DOB if FIN is not available.




7. In the top pane, highlight the correct patient, in the bottom pane highlight the encounter that needs to have the encounter type changed from Service Interaction to Recurring, and click **OK**.






8. There will be a pop-up asking if you want to create a new encounter, for this situation select **NO**. In this case you want to edit the recurring encounter not create a new one.



9. In the **Encounter Information** tab, change the **Encounter Type** back to **Recurring**, click OK to file the conversation.



- 10. The Parent encounter should now be fixed.
 - ***Note: Scheduling will need to be notified. They will have to re-activate any appointments that were scheduled against the Parent encounter, as they would have been cancelled when the encounter was accidentally discharged.***
