When a HIM specialist notices a missing element (for example, blanks in transcribed documents or missing information on a scanned document), they create Missing Element note in PowerChart and send the Missing Element note to the physician for completion. A Missing Element deficiency is automatically created for the physician, and a new task is created in the Missing Element task queue. After the physician signs the Missing Element note, the Missing Element deficiency is completed. The task in the Missing Element task queue is updated to an On Hold status with the pass reason Analysis - Received Missing Element.

This workflow provides a way to communicate missing elements to providers and to track that communication as a deficiency to ensure physicians are fulfilling the missing element, therefore ensuring the medical record is accurate and complete.
