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- Prescribers **must NOT** place therapy follow-up orders as this is for therapists to place for documentation purposes.
- The follow-up orders were designed to task treatment documentation based on how frequently the therapists wish to document on patients' charts. It is **the therapists' responsibility** to manage this, **not the prescribers**. The therapy follow-up orders include the following:
 - Occupational Therapy Follow Up: Occupational Therapy SMART Follow Up
 - Physiotherapy Follow Up: Physiotherapy SMART Follow Up
 - Speech Language Pathology Follow Up
 - Recreation Therapy Follow Up

Tips to Submitting a Ticket:

-  Give as much detail as possible to ensure the Command Centre is able to quickly understand the issue and place it in a priority sequence.
-  **Include the name of the person who is experiencing the issue and their contact information.**
-  Select the appropriate category, sub-category and priority of the issue.
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Attach a screenshot of the issue, or to help explain the issue, whenever possible, keeping in mind that no patient-identifiable information should be included in the screenshot.
