

Navigating Interactive View



- 1. **Toolbar**: Allows you to take action in Interactive View. See the Toolbar on page 2 for more information.
- Navigator: Displays available views.
 Views are displayed as bands and the
 sections available in each view are
 displayed under the bands.
- Date Range Bar: Displays date results.
 Use the date range bar to select the retrieval range for results.
- Filter Options: Displays filters to narrow your results. Select the appropriate filters to narrow your search.
- 5. Filter Window: Displays search results.
- 6. **Interactive View**: Displays results, the selected view, and the date in the main window in Interactive View.

- 7. **Cell**: Displays results and charted values. Double-click a cell and enter a result to chart a result. Enter the result then click the sign button on the toolbar.
- Comment Icon: Allows you to view a result comment. Right-click a result and select Add Comment to add a comment.
- Flag Icon: Displays results that are tagged. Right-click a result and select Flag to tag a result.
- Calculation Icon: Displays calculated results Right-click the result with a calculation icon to view calculations.

Adding an ECT Band

- 1. Click View on your top toolbar
- 2. Click Layout at the bottom of the list
- 3. Click Navigator Bands
- 4. Find and Click "Electro Convulsive Therapy"
- 5. Click the arrow pointing right
- 6. Click Okay
- 7. Close and reopen your patient's chart.
- 8. Now that you have added the ECT Band, it will be available for you on all patients going forward. You only have to add this band once.

Adding an ECT Band

 Double clicking the blue or gray line for the heading under a time slot creates a checkmark, indicating that section is open for charting.



- 2. Click into boxes within the column you opened and answer the corresponding questions.
- 3. When you are done filling in your section, click the green checkmark to sign. ✓

Adding Documentation at a Specific Date and Time

 Right Click one of the times at the top of the column to change your time interval view or to "Insert Date/Time" to create a column for a specific time.



- 2. Once your new column is made, document your assessment or therapy as normal.
- 3. Click Sign.

Flagging Annotations

- 1. Select the date and time column.
- 2. Click **Action** and select **Flag Annotation**.
- 3. Enter the date, time, title, and annotation.
- 4. Click Sign.

Uncharting a Result

- 1. Right-click the result you want to unchart and select **Unchart**.
- 1. If applicable, enter a comment.
- 2. Click Sign.

Flagging Patient Events

1. Select then right-click a result.

Tip: To select multiple results at once, hold CTRL as you select the appropriate results.

- 2. From the menu, select Flag.
- 3. If you want to leave a comment, select **Flag** with **Comment** then enter a comment.
- 4. Click OK.

- In the Navigator column click on "ECT Monitoring Record" and start documenting.
 - IMPORTANT: This is where the prescriber will complete their documentation in IVIEW for ECT monitoring record.
