Icon	Definition	Explanation
	OB Admission Assessment needs to be completed	This comes to the tracking board whenever a patient is admitted to 2EST. Icon will disappear when form is completed and signed.
	Task list	Appears with a task needs to be completed (such as labs, patient care, and assessment).
	Ht/Wt/ Allergy PowerForm needs to be completed	This come to the tracking board whenever a patient is admitted to 2EST. Icon will disappear when form is completed and signed.
	Patient is going to be discharged	When the provider enters the order for the patient to be discharged the icon appears.
	Patient is on phototherapy	When the doctor writes the order for the patient to have bili lights the icon appears.
	Car seat challenge needs to be done	When a car seat challenge order is placed. When order is completed the icon will be removed from the tracking board.
	Patient is formula feeding	Appears when a nurse documents infant feeding as bottle on the admission PowerForm in the birth plan section.
	Patient is breastfeeding	Appears when a nurse documents infant feeding as breast on the admission PowerForm in the birth plan section.
	OB Hemorrhage Risk Assessment	Appears when the Risk Assessment is completed. Results are green – no risk, yellow - moderate risk, red – high risk.
	OB Hemorrhage Assessment or re-assessment	Appears at admission and upon documentation of delivery.
	Patient had no prenatal care	Appears when a nurse documents prenatal care as none on the admission PowerForm in the general info section.



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P

Patient is GBS positive

Appears when a nurse documents GBS positive on the admission PowerForm in the transcribed lab section.

N

Patient is GBS negative

Appears when a nurse documents GBS negative on the admission PowerForm in the transcribed lab section.

U

Patient is GBS unknown

Appears when a nurse documents GBS negative on the admission PowerForm in the transcribed lab section.



Baby is up for adoption

Appears when a nurse documents baby for adoption as on the admission PowerForm in the birth plan section



Surrogate mother

Appears when a nurse documents surrogate pregnancy as yes on the admission PowerForm on the birth plan section



Epidural needed or patient has an epidural

Icon is manually placed by nurse



No visitors allowed

Icon is manually placed by nurse



Patient is diabetic

Icon is manually placed by nurse



Rhogam

Documentation about mother's blood type will indicate if the baby's blood needs to be tested. Both blood types should be reviewed to determine if mom is a Rhogam candidate .



Orders for Nurse Review

Appears after a patient's delivery documentation is charted. This is a reminder to finalize and disassociate in FetaLink once the patient's 2 hour recovery period is complete.



Finalize and dissociate FetaLink

Alerts the nurse that there is new orders written and needs reviewing.



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Icons on the Tracking Board Toolbar



What the Icons allow you to do

Allows you to add an order to the patient in which you highlight on the tracking board

Allows you to pick what part of the chart you wish to open up.

Opens up to the pregnancy summary of the highlighted patient.

Allows you to assign and unassign yourself to a patient as the nurse in the RN column of the tracking board.

Allows nurse to run reports (birth log).

Allows you to manually add or remove a *Communication* to the tracking board, such as patient is a diabetic or patient is a surrogate.
