



# CONTEXTUAL VIEW/ SPLIT SCREEN

## HOSPITAL INFORMATION SYSTEM (HIS)

### FOR PRESCRIBERS

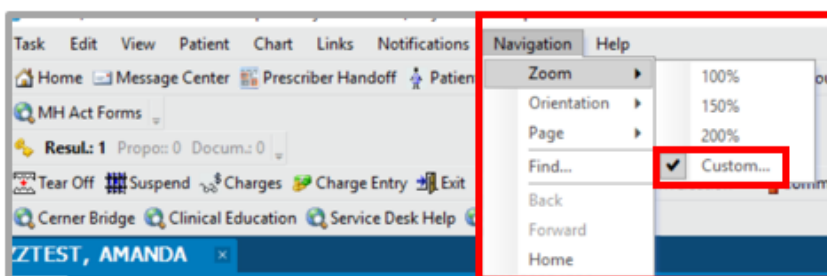
Setting up Contextual View as a physician/prescriber in a patient's chart.

**NOTE:** Your screen resolution must be at least 1600 pixels wide, otherwise **Contextual View does not work**. You will need to reduce the zoom to 75%.

Here are two options:

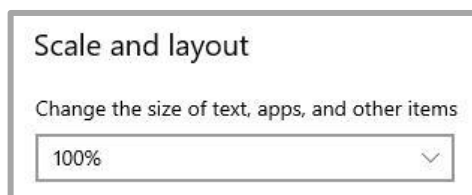
#### 1. Zoom higher than 100% in Patient's Chart


If you zoom in to anything higher than 100% in a chart, all MPage components you have pulled to the right will disappear. The zoom can be adjusted from the **Navigation** tab on the top toolbar. Select **custom** and set to 75%.

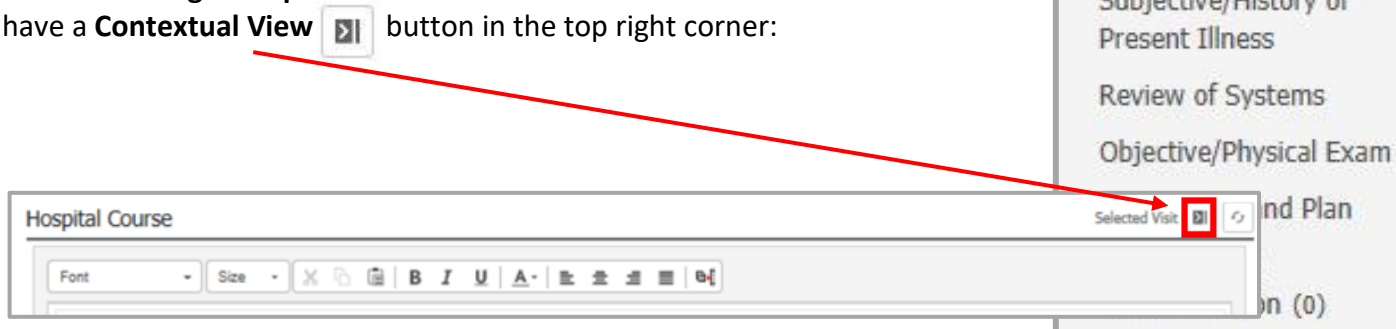


#### 2. Display setting on hospital device higher than 100% Zoom

If the **Display > Scale and Layout** settings on your computer are set to more than 100% zoom



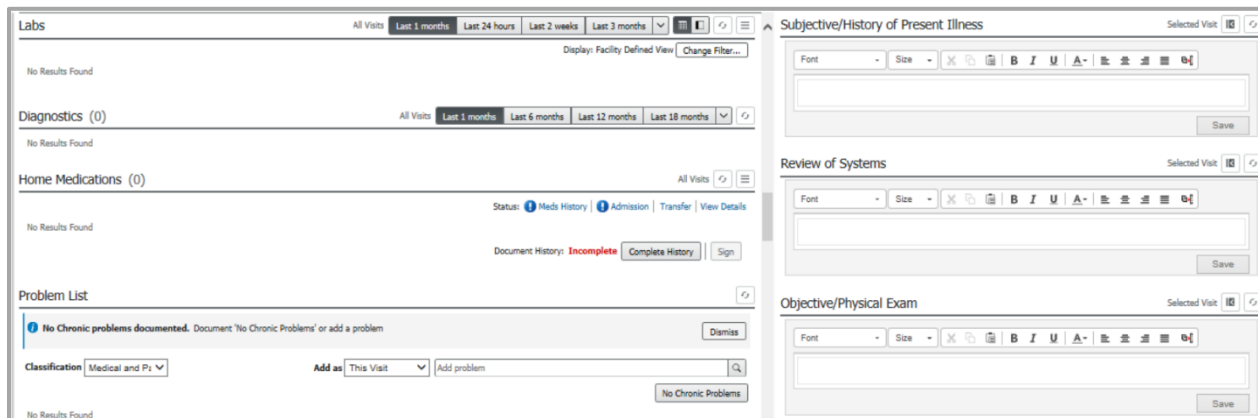
All of the **MPage components** that allow for narrative documentation will have a **Contextual View**  button in the top right corner:





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**Contextual view**, or **split screen**, allows you to review the clinical information components in the left column while documenting notes in the right column.



1. Select the tab you want to **split the screen** for, e.g. Admission.
2. In the free text component (excluding Presenting Complaints), which you want to move to the right column, click the  contextual view button.
3. **Repeat Step 1** for any other components you want to move to the right column.
4. To move a component back to the left column, click the remove from contextual view button in the component.

You will have to manually go into each of the following **MPage components** and click the **arrow button**  to get them all on the right side.
