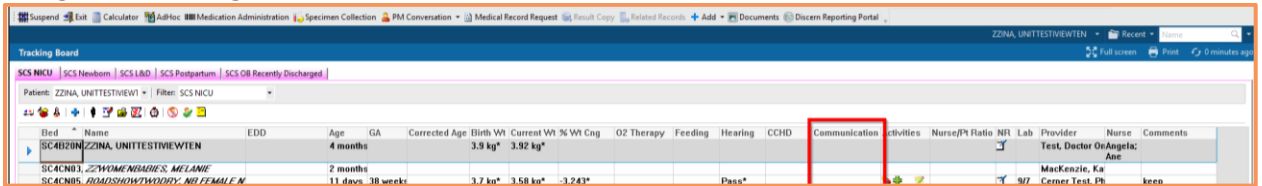
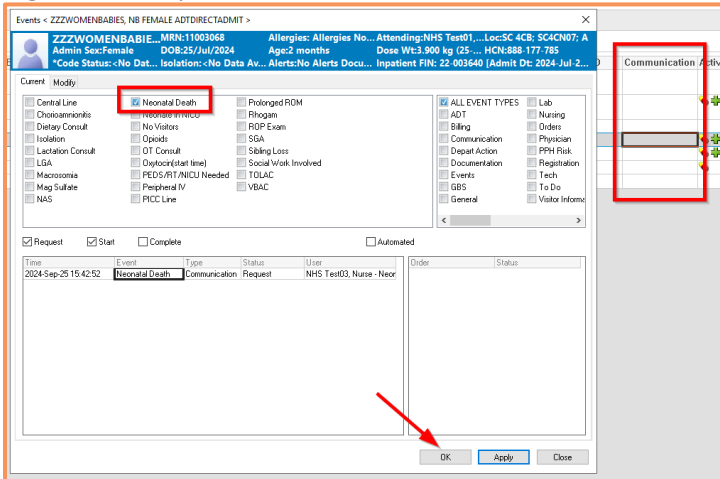


## NICU NURSE

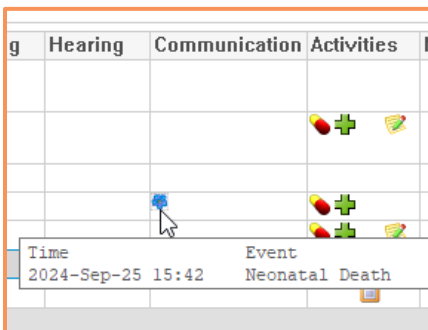
1. Confirms neonatal death with provider
2. Mother is NOT a patient
3. Navigate to tracking board under **Communication** section



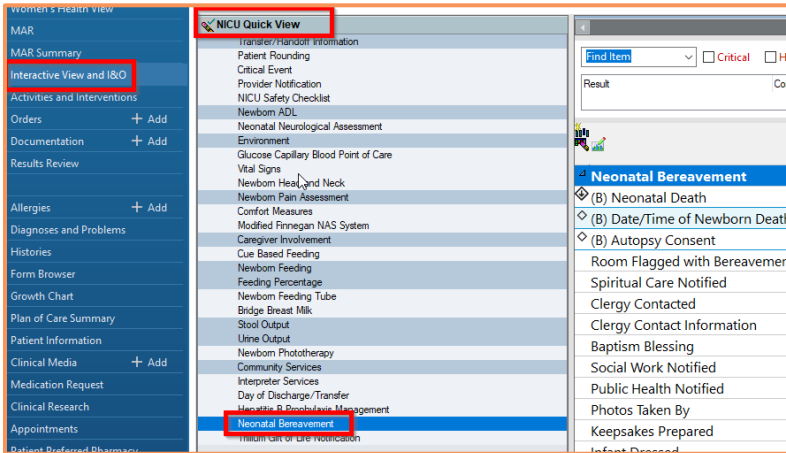
4. Right click to open an **Events window** and select **Neonatal Death**



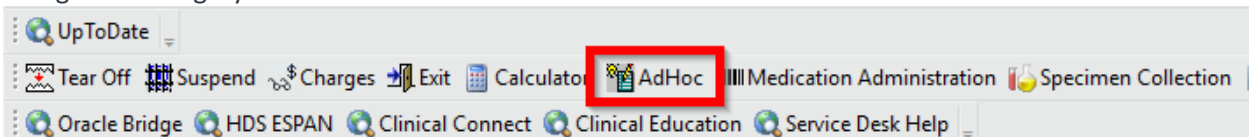
5. A Blue flower will display in the **Communication** column on tracking board to signify a Neonatal Death



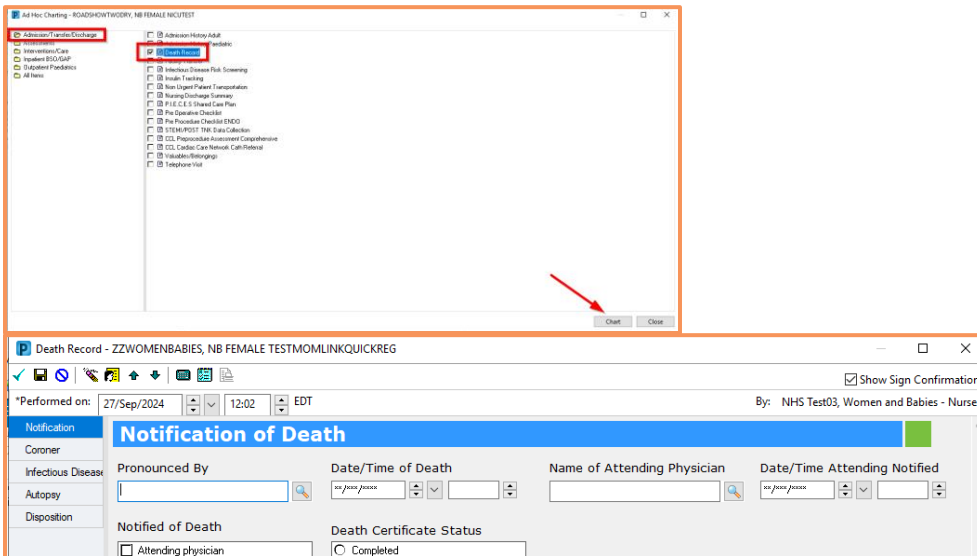
6. Navigate to the **NICU Quick View** band and select **Neonatal Bereavement** complete applicable documentation. When charting is complete, press the green checkmark ✓ to save

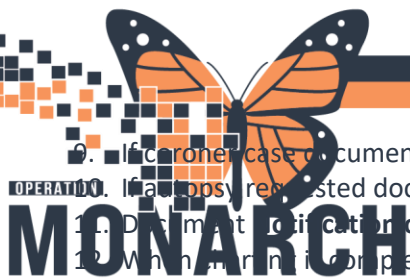


7. Navigate to the grey bar and select **AdHoc**



8. Navigate to **Admission/Discharge/Transfer** folder and select **Death Record PowerForm** and then select **Chart**

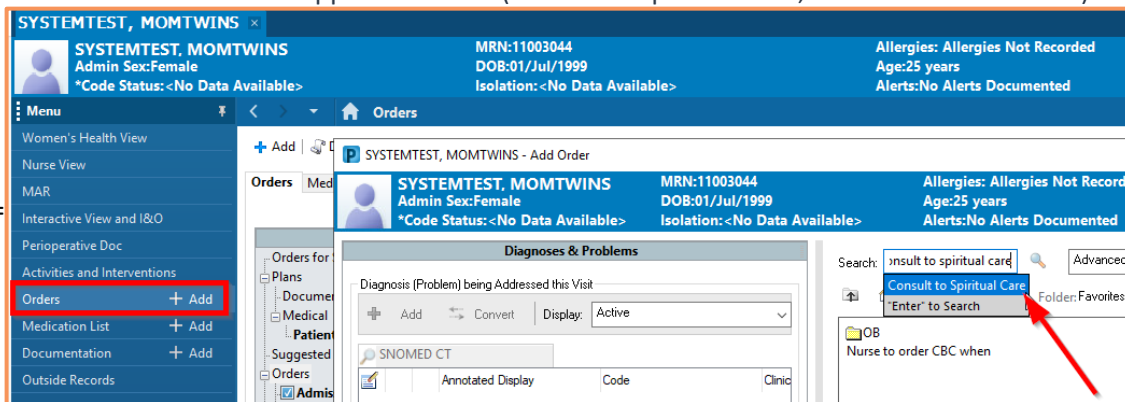




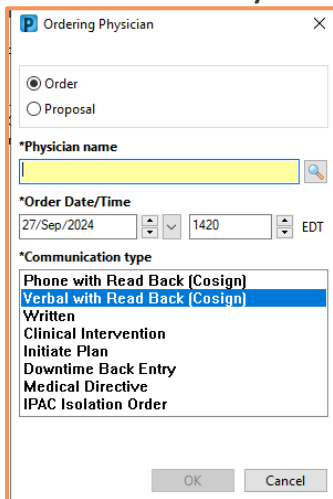

9. If coroner case document **Coroner** section of **Death Record PowerForm**
10. If autopsy requested document in **Autopsy** section of **Death Record PowerForm**
11. Document **Notification of Death** section in the **Death Record PowerForm**
12. When form is complete, press the green checkmark ✓ to sign and save

13. Place **Communication Order** for **Spiritual Needs** and/or **Social Work** as applicable
  - a. From the blue Table of Contents, select **+Add** beside **Orders**
  - b. Search and select applicable order (Consult to Spiritual Care, Consult to Social Work)



14. Search and select **Physician name** and select appropriate communication type. Then press OK.



15. Enter in order details and click **Sign** when complete

16. Utilize **Capacity Management** for patient transport request if infant is going to the morgue

17. Discharge patient with PM conversation **Discharge Encounter**

18. Fill in required discharge information then press **Complete**
