



CODE PINK NEONATAL HOSPITAL INFORMATION SYSTEM (HIS)

WOMEN AND BABIES & NICU CLINICAL STAFF

During a Code Pink NEONATAL emergency, all documentation will remain on paper as per site policy using the **Newborn Resuscitation Record 900372** found in Source Net

- Paper documentation will be placed in the patient chartlet and scanned into Millennium upon patient discharge

Back Entry Documentation:

- After the Code Pink has ended, certain data elements will need to be back entered into Millennium.
 - Once resuscitation is complete, specific newborn delivery data fields (e.g. Apgars) will need to be back entered into the **Newborn Delivery Data** band in the maternal chart
 - Necessary **BORN** fields to be filled out pertaining to delivery of Mother and Child and Resuscitation done by OB/NICU nurse
 - The OB nurse is required to enter data from the paper Resuscitation Record into **Interactive View and I&O (iView)** in the **maternal chart** as applicable
 - **NICU Procedures** – eg. Insertion of lines, tubes, drains, devices to be documented in the Newborn chart in iVeiw

Result Copy:

- Documentation will be result copied from the maternal chart to the newborn chart so all applicable documentation is up to date

Critical Event on Newborn Chart:

- NICU to navigate to **Critical Event** section in the **Newborn Quick View** band in iView and document the applicable information
