Comments: Is the plan appropriate for this patient ever? Or was it suggested as a part of incorrect documentation, wrong patient, etc.

**Decision [64]**

Description: Plan appropriate at this time?

Comments: Is the plan appropriate for the patient right now? Was it suggested as part of correct documentation? Does the nurse feel that this plan is appropriate for the patient to be on now or at any point in the future?

Description: Leave Plan of Care as Suggested at this time
