

MIPS ACI Measure Considerations: Clinical Information Reconciliation - Review of the patient's medication, including the name, dosage, frequency, and route of each medication.

Modified Meaningful Use Consideration: The EP performs medication reconciliation for more than 50 percent. More than 50 percent of permissible prescriptions written by the EP are queried for a drug formulary and transmitted electronically using CEHRT

MIPS Clinical Performance Improvement Activity Consideration: Implementation of medication management practice improvements
