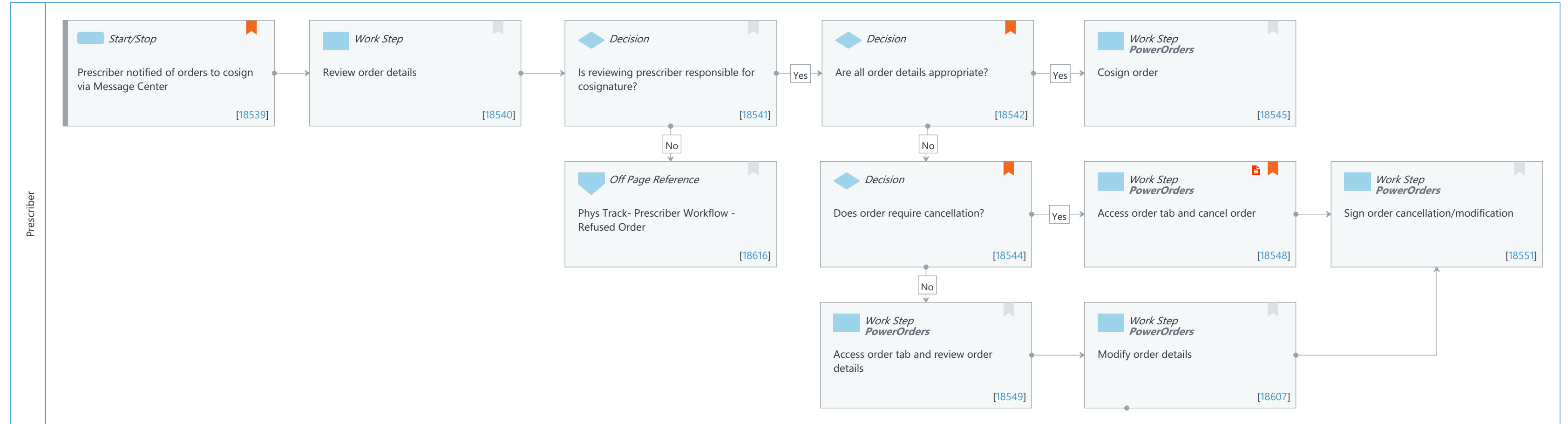

Description: Does order require cancellation?

Comments: The rejection of a co-sign order in message center doesn't automatically cancel the order or alter the status of the order. The order remains active and must be evaluated for validity and a determination made whether to keep the original order or cancel altogether upon review. Most cases, if the co-signee of an order was selected incorrectly to co-sign an order and the correct co-signee is unknown, the best course of action is to reject/refuse the order for co-sign and manually cancel/discontinue the order. Please note, the above does not apply to proposed orders.
