

Start/Stop [3]

Description: Encounter was registered on incorrect patient.



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Work Step [4]

Description: Review each encounter's information to confirm a "cancel encounter" is necessary.

Work Step [28]

- Description: Move patient to Checkout location on the ED tracking board. Add comment to comment column indicating incorrect registration
- Comments: You want to move the patient to the checkout location to help the nurse avoid documenting on the incorrect encounter, which would then require an encounter combine. Only the reg clerk should have the ability to move the patient to checkout, and not the nurses.

Decision [5]

Description: Are there automated orders that were placed upon registration that need to be cancelled prior?

Work Step [6]

- Description: Open order profile from FIrstNet chart and void automated orders under direction from ED Nurse.
- Comments: The Reg Clerk should have the privilege to perform order voiding on only automated orders placed secondary to patient registration.

This is necessary before the system will allow you to cancel an encounter.

Description: Complete the "Cancel Encounter" conversation.
