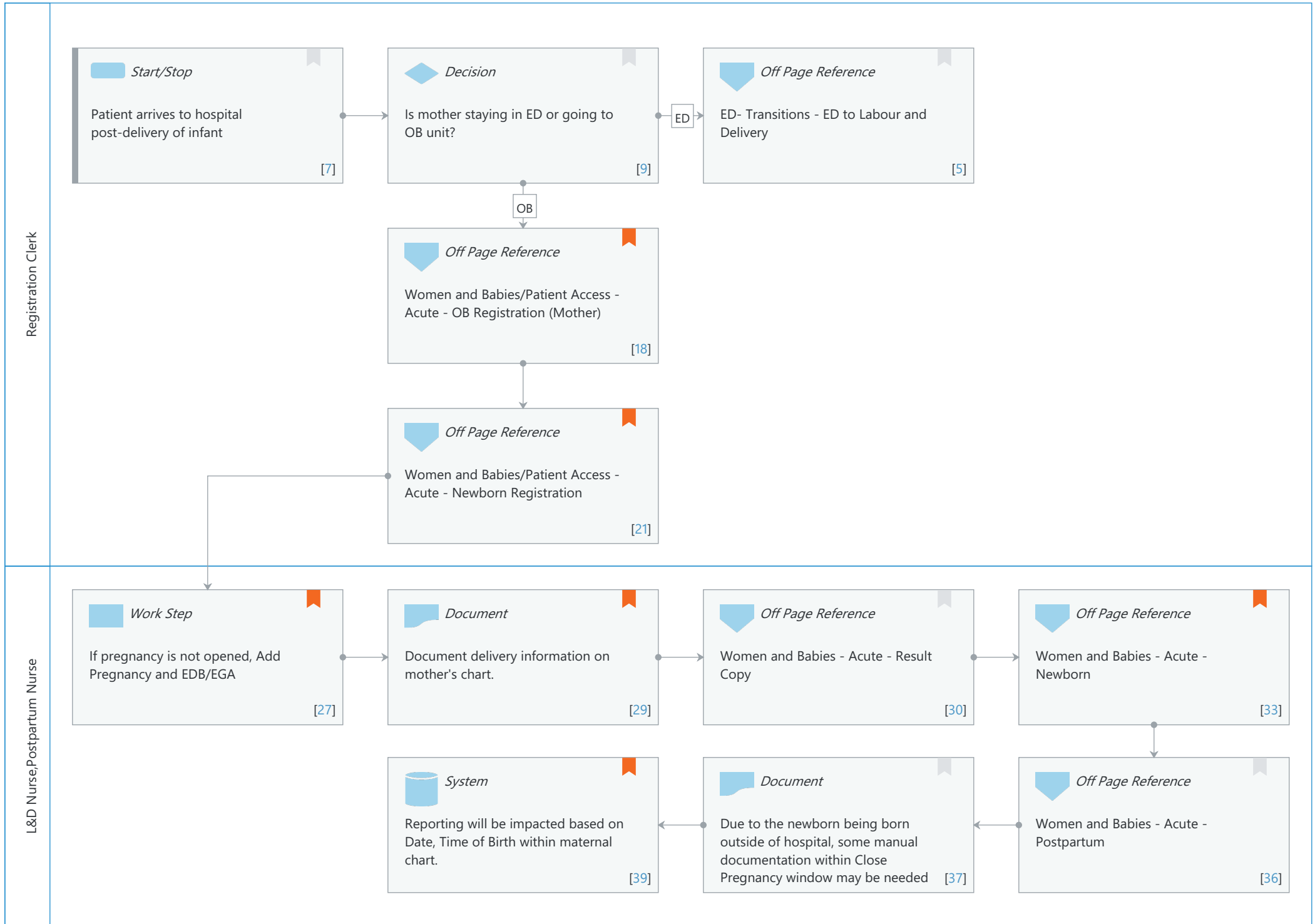

Workflow Link: Women and Babies/Patient Access - Acute - OB Registration (Mother)

Comments: Steps may be completed by variety of roles based on client workflows.

**Off Page Reference [21]**

Workflow Link: Women and Babies/Patient Access - Acute - Newborn Registration

Comments: It may be appropriate for Registration/Patient Access Department to register the newborn, depending on the client's preference.

Note: Ensure that a Newborn registration conversation is leveraged so that the Mother/Baby Link is created. (User would skip any "pre-registration" steps at this point.)

**Work Step [27]**

Description: If pregnancy is not opened, Add Pregnancy and EDB/EGA

Comments: Even if delivery already occurred, the following items are reliant on opening the pregnancy:

Pregnancy Summary Document  
Postpartum MPage  
Viewing  
Auto-Update to Historical Control on Pregnancy Closure

Use Add Pregnancy Cloud Component, if available.

If not available, use Add Pregnancy workflow component.

**Document [29]**

Description: Document delivery information on mother's chart.

Comments: Make sure to document "Delivered outside of L&amp;D unit" within "Risk

## Future State: Women and Babies - Acute - Delivery Outside of Hospital

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Factors:" DTA

Documentation of "Date, Time of Birth:" on the mother's chart will trigger patient to appear on the Birth Log Report. Client policy should dictate whether this is appropriate or not per facility. Consider risk management when reviewing.

Be aware of delivery charging triggers, and only document what is appropriate from a charging perspective.

**Off Page Reference [33]**

Workflow Link: Women and Babies - Acute - Newborn

Comments: Additional documentation may be needed for outborn newborns when completing admission documentation such as Apgars, etc.

"Date, Time of Birth" may need to be manually charted on newborn's chart if determined not appropriate to document on mother's chart.

**System [39]**

Description: Reporting will be impacted based on Date, Time of Birth within maternal chart.

Comments: Since the delivery did not occur in-house, it may not be appropriate for patients to appear on Birth Log/Delivery Summary reports. Determine per client policy.

**Document [37]**

Description: Due to the newborn being born outside of hospital, some manual documentation within Close Pregnancy window may be needed
